



Chainsaw Training

Our chainsaw training courses cover various levels of operation depending on the needs of each student.

+What to expect

Competency Assessments

AHCMOM213: Operate & Maintain Chainsaws - learn how to carry out routine maintenance of the powerhead and completion of cutting of fallen trees

AHCMOM205: Fell small trees - plan and fell small trees that are deemed low risk hazards; preparing, felling and clean up

FWPCOT2254: Maintain chainsaws - learn parts and features of the chainsaw and how to carry out routine maintenance to ensure the powerhead operates correctly

FWPCOT2273: Trim and cut felled trees - learn how to cut and trim tree branches and trunks and the way different forces within the tree effect cutting techniques

FWPCOT2253: Fell trees manually (basic) - learn safety, maintenance and operations; carry out assessment and felling of trees with low level complexity

FWPCOT3350: Fell trees manually (intermediate) - carry out manual felling of trees with intermediate level characteristics and complexity requiring assessment and practical felling skills

FWPCOT3351: Fell trees manually (advanced) - assess and perform felling of trees that have advanced characteristics and complexity requiring significant assessment and advanced practical felling skills.

FWPCOT3301: Trim trees using a pole saw - learn how to safely operate a battery or fuel powdered pole saw to trim tree branches

FWPCOT2259: Cut materials with a hand-held chainsaw - safely prepare and cut timber and polymer materials, such as poly pipes with a hand-held chainsaw



Structure of training

Face-to-face

Our chainsaw training is held over one to three days, depending on experience and units to be achieved. Training is held in an off-the-job, safe and live environment, where all of the theory and practical training for the units can be delivered and assessed.

Locations

We have dedicated training facilities in Ipswich QLD and Tamworth NSW which have training rooms and all the necessary training equipment essential for this course.

Alternatively, we can deliver this course at your work place if that is more convenient (travel fees and minimum numbers apply).

If we travel to you, you will need to provide suitable trees for felling (we will specify the requirements for such).

Recognition of Prior Learning

Depending on the knowledge and experience you have gained through working in the industry, you may qualify for subject credits which will allow you to complete the course faster! Contact our office on 1300 123 778 to discuss.

Cost

The course costs range from \$250 - \$1500 per person depending on the chainsaw training required.

Duration

The completion time for this training is 1 - 3 days depending on experience and units to be completed.

Accreditation

Students will be awarded a Statement of Attainment for their nationally recognised units of competency.

You will need suitable work clothes for practical activities, safety boots, helmet, hearing protection, safety glasses and chainsaw chaps.
